

Herdina Construction Trades Camp

We partner with Minnesota State Community and Technical College to organize a two-week camp over the summer for high school students age 15 and up. Herdina Construction Trades Camp attendees get to work on a project alongside industry professionals who are Home Builders Care Foundation volunteers. Students receive college credit and are eligible for scholarships, too. 16 students graduated from the program in 2025 and organizers are excited for another great camp June 1-5 and 8-12, 2026.

Scholarship Program
In 2024, we supported 21 area students working towards degrees related to the construction industry. 4 graduating high school students and 15 post-secondary students were awarded a total of \$17,000 in scholarships. Since beginning the program, Home Builders Care Foundation has given away nearly \$440,000 to students.

Approximate application periods:

- High school students planning to pursue a career in construction: Jan. 1 April 1
  - Awards announced in May
- College students enrolled locally in a construction-related major: Sept. 1 Nov. 15
  - Awards announced in January
